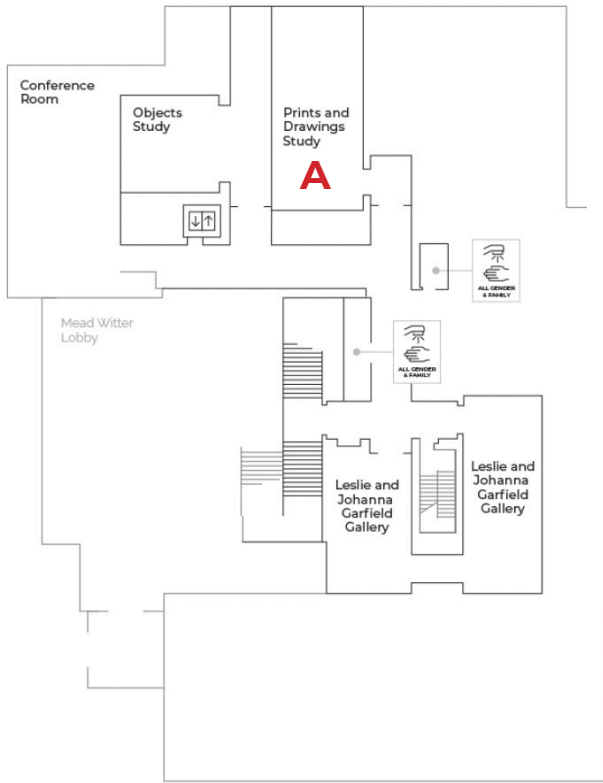

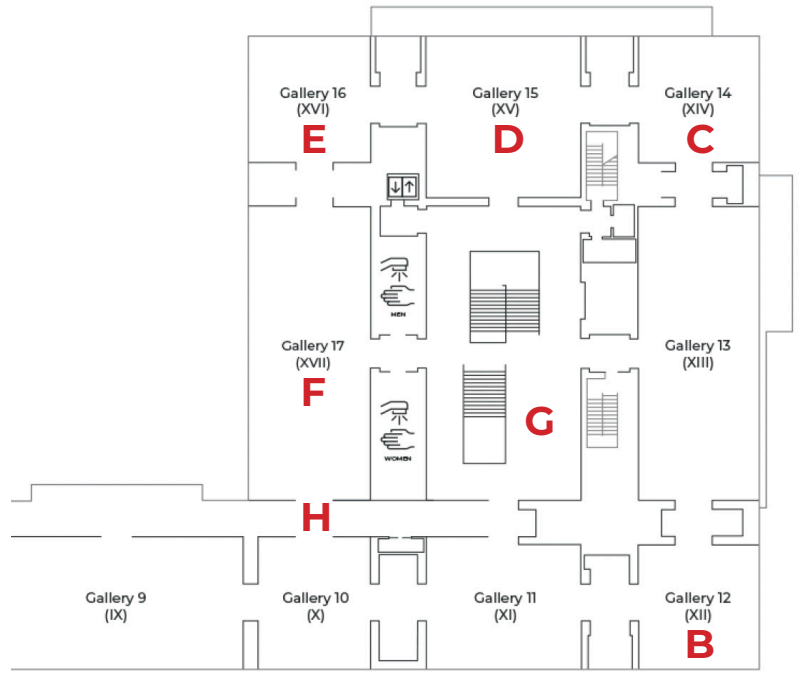

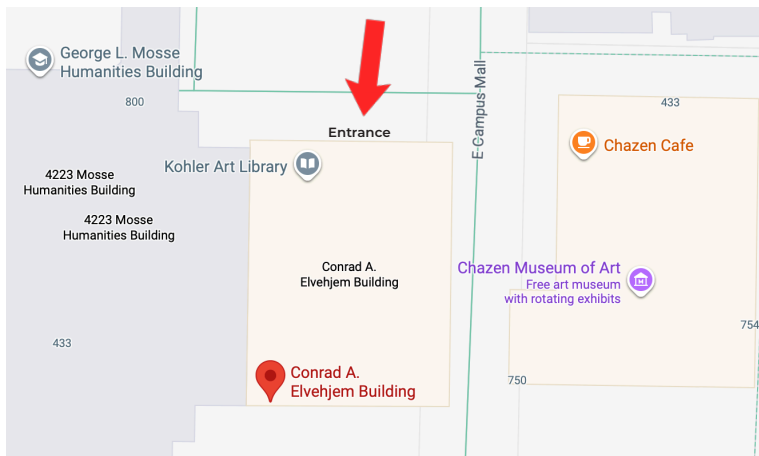
Chazen Building Floor 2



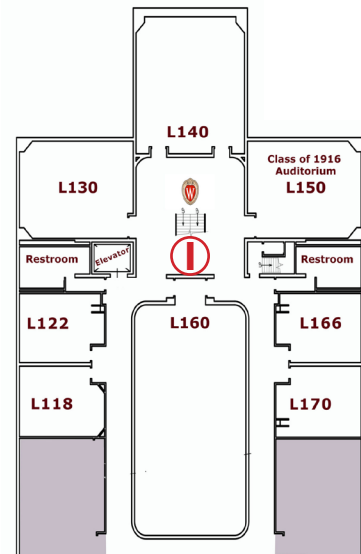
